

CHILD MALTREATMENT (Part 4): Regulations and Contact Information for Reporting in the Prairies

All persons in Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba have a legal responsibility to report any suspected child maltreatment. Reports can be made to the nearest Child and Family Services, First Nations Child and Family Services, or local police/RCMP. If the child is in immediate danger, call 9-1-1.

Reporting Regulations

- It is a legal responsibility for witnessed or suspected abuse/neglect.
- The person reporting is not required to provide their name.
- If you believe a child is in immediate danger, call local police, RCMP or 911.
