PRAIRIE OVERDOSE CRISIS: A PANDEMIC WITHIN A PANDEMIC

Overdoses have increased as a result of limitations in access to services during COVID-19 and an increase in negative mental health. Many people who use substances have been exposed to excessively unreliable street drugs during COVID-19.

Suggested Strategies

Increase availability of and training for Naloxone kits. Administering Naloxone has prevented many fatal overdoses during COVID-19

Encourage people who use drugs to practice harm reduction strategies over sobriety during COVID-19. Such as: test dosing, carrying Naloxone, avoidance of stockpiling, and establishing a socially distanced buddy system while using.

Advocate for the funding and opening of safe consumption sites and addiction services.

Increase visitation frequency with people who use substances, especially at-risk youth.
